



Oshkosh Fine Arts Association Plein Air Festival

August 16-19, 2018

Thank you for your interest in our first annual Plein Air Event. This will be a 4 day event, painting from Thursday to Saturday, ending with a reception and sale on Sunday August 19, 2018 at the UW-Oshkosh Alumni Welcome and Conference Center. Artists are invited to paint throughout the city of Oshkosh. A detailed prospectus will be sent out when plans are finalized.

Day 1, Thursday, August 16: The event with a Sunrise Paint at Menomonie Park on stunning Lake Winnebago. That evening we will be allowed into the Leach Amphitheater to paint during Waterfest.

Day 2, Friday, August 17: We have the opportunity to paint on the beautiful grounds of the Paine Art Center and Gardens in the morning. Later that day we will gather at Fox River Brewing Co.

Day 3, Saturday, August 18: In the morning artists are welcome to paint downtown at the Oshkosh Farmers Market. In the afternoon and early evening enjoy the lovely Jazz music while painting at the Oshkosh Jazz and Arts Festival at William Stieger Park.

Day 4, Sunday, August 19: Our artist reception and painting sale will be at UW Oshkosh Alumni Welcome and Conference Center from 9:30 – 12:30.

2018 Guidelines

- All work needs to be stamped prior to painting. Stamping will be done at the beginning of each day.
- Painting must be done within the city limits of Oshkosh. A map will be provided.
- 95% of the painting must be done on-site in the true spirit of Plein Air Painting.
- Registration limited to 30 artists (first to apply.) Artists may participate in any or all events.
- Accepted media: Oil, acrylic, mixed media, watercolor, pastels, gouache, graphite, or pen and ink.
- Finished work must be framed or gallery ready to hang. We reserve the right to reject any painting that is improperly framed, or painting not of professional standards.
- Artist may display up to 3 pieces of artwork.
- No piece can be larger than 20 inches in either direction when framed.
- All work entered in the show must have a visible stamp (works on paper can be shown to staff for approval before backing goes on or cut hole to show stamp.)
- Art must be delivered to the UW-Oshkosh Alumni Welcome and Conference Center between 7 and 8 AM, Sunday, August 19. Painting pickup will be from 12:30 - 1 PM.
- Paintings will be sold at the price selected by the artist. OFAA will receive 35% commission
- Artists are required to attend the reception.
- Off-easel sales are prohibited.
- Judging will be done at the UW-Oshkosh Alumni Welcome and Conference Center between 10 AM and 11:30 AM on Sunday, August 19.
- Awards will be announced at 12 Noon.
- Registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
