Just a reminder that Kris Parin’s watercolor workshop will take place May 15-17 at the Oshkosh Senior Center Annex. Kris’ work can be seen on her website www.krisparins.com. The workshop title is “The Power of Watercolor and here is her description:

Learn to employ the flowing nature of watercolor in creating a powerful painting. Emphasis will be on planning, values, composition, using landscapes and cityscapes with figures for subject matter. See how to use a digital camera and computer as tools for planning and analyzing paintings. Intermediate to Advanced Level; Artists using acrylic in a transparent manner are also welcome.

At the present time we have 12 people enrolled with a maximum of 20 for the three day workshop. The cost to members is \$100 which includes continental breakfast and snacks.
