PRIZE - WINNING APPLE CAKE

2 cups sugar

1 teaspoon salt

1 ¼ cups oil

2 teaspoons cinnamon

2 eggs

3 cups peeled & diced apples (granny smith apples work good)

3 cups flour

1 cup chopped walnuts

1 teaspoonful baking soda

1cup raisins (optional)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray a 9 x 13 " pan with oil spray.

Believe this or not! Put all ingredients into one large bowl. Mix with your hands as you would a meatloaf, gently but thoroughly; do not use a spoon or mixer! Pat the batter into a 9 x 13 " pan and bake for 1 hour. COOL before cutting.

Almost all signage is in Helvetica. Just a few logos that we see that are in Helvetica include Crate and Barrel, Target, Macy's. The Madonnas of Leningrad by Debra Dean. This is an intergenerational book, mostly about a middle aged daughter, an artist, and her mother who has alzheimer's disease. The mother worked at the Hermitage in St. Petersburg, Russia during World War II, and remembers all of the paintings and where they hung despite her condition. A woman who cleaned in the museum encouraged her to learn all of the paintings so that there would be a record of what was taken out of the museum and where it hung. It is a poignant look at a family and what they do not know about each other, and the pain of seeing parents grow old. This and the art remembered will appeal to many in our group. (Michele Missner)

MINUTES – September 8, 2009**

The meeting was called to order by President Peggy McDaniel at 6:35 pm at the Oshkosh Senior Center.

Minutes - The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Cori Conrad, and approved as read. Secretary Jenna Larson was absent.

Treasurer's Report – Steve Miller reported the checking account at \$1087.19 and the money market account as \$8581.24, for a total of \$10,568.43. Of that, \$4287.68 is in the scholarship fund.

Art Fair Report – Carolyn Sturma reported that \$1030 was taken in by the silent auction for scholarships and approximately \$1100 was raised through soda sales.

Workshops – Michele Missner, Maxine Nobbe, and Kathy Murphy agreed to co-chair our workshops this year. A preference sheet will be circulated to give the committee a better idea of which workshops & or programs to go forward with.

Scholarship Committee – Michaelene Urban reported that a silent auction with wine-themed baskets will be a part of our holiday party on December 5th, 2009 at Robbins restaurant. To be green, we are asking members to supply baskets and items to fill themed baskets and they will be put together by the committee. McKnight Carlson has agreed to wholesale some wine to us, and we will combine this with art options at the auction. The event will start at 6:00pm. Steve Miller made a motion to keep the price at \$20 including either a glass of wine or a non-alcoholic beverage with each reservation. After discussion, Corey Conrad seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Holiday Committee – A holiday committee was formed with Carolyn Sturma as chair with Michaelene, Shelley, Julie, Peggy Wursbach and Peggy McDaniel.

Hospitality Committee – Joan Cason reported that she still needs people to sign up for November, January, February, March & June. A sheet was passed around.

Historian Report – Shelly Ingala asked for any

pictures or articles from workshops or from the last holiday party.

Old Business – Steve Miller reminded members to please pay for OFAA t-shirts if they have not already.

New Business - Jason Timmons, who has a gallery at 708 Oregon Street, has agreed to hold a member exhibit for the November Gallery Walk. A motion was made to participate for \$150 by Corey Conrad and seconded by Joan Cason. The motion carried unanimously.

Michaelene reported that there will be a Corning glass exhibition October 15-18, 2009 at Bergstrom-Mahler Gallery. Cheryl McCarthy reported there will be a Fine Arts and Fine Crafts show November 7 and 8 at the Oshkosh Convention Center. Reservations must be received by Cheryl for an October 15th deadline. Fred Behlendorf reported that the Masonic Temple is open for artists to exhibit during Art Walk. Peggy McDaniel reported that the Board voted to use highway billboards for 2 weeks prior to the Art Fair in 2010, and these will be changeable signs which will accommodate displays of art by various members. Kathy Murphy will find out more about how our digital art needs to be saved for this project.

Program Committee – Carolyn Sturma reported that on October 6, 2009 we will be having a Gourd & Pine Needle Art Program. In November, Michele Missner will give a demonstration on abstraction, and abstract art and we will have a “Chili Dump” dinner. More details will be compiled by chair Adela Baumhardt. December will be the Holiday Party. In January, Joye Moon will be sharing DVD's of the Watercolor Society participants. In February, we hope to have Jann Schonke critique our personal art at the meeting. Fred Behlendorf suggested that he would like a program on copyrighting. We will investigate that possibility.

A big thank you goes out to Michaelene Urban for pulling together a terrific trip to Chicago. It was very successful, and a “wonderful time” was expressed by all who attended.
