Meeting adjourned.


Member Spotlight

There are 14 members exhibiting in the Member's Booth at the Art Fair. Please turn in the "Individual Member's Booth List" at our last meeting in June. Pick up "pealable stickers" to attach to each card & each piece of hanging artwork. Place your first & last initial & the price on the sticker. You may include a business card on your artwork if you wish. Please only use whole dollar amounts. "Example: You cannot sell 4 cards for \$10 unless they are packaged together as one piece with one sticker of \$10." If you have any way to display your cards in a box or small rack, that would work great!

Show up at 8 am to hang your artwork & set up your cards. The limit is 3 pictures per member. Please respect this limit until there is found we have room for more. A list of who has committed to monitoring the booth will be emailed out before the Art Fair.

We will be putting a sign on the table that tax is included in all artwork pieces. A receipt will be issued to the customer for their purchase.

At 4pm, be available to take down your artwork. Max Nobbe & Joanne will be calculating the payout for the purchases. These will be in the form of cash or individual checks. If a customer buys a hanging piece of art, the check can be made out to that artist by the customer. If the customer buys other items which includes other artists, the check will need to be made out to OFAA.
