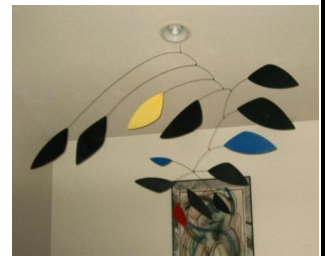

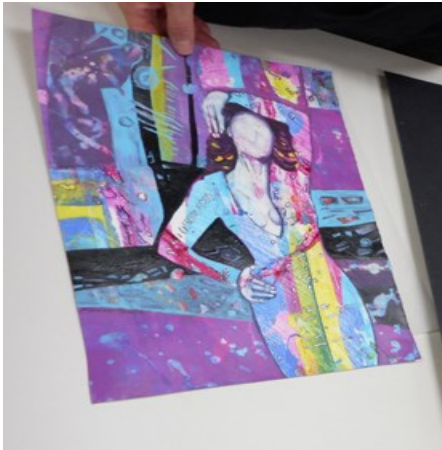
New Business:
